Be it ordained by the Caldwell County Fiscal Court of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

WHEREAS, the proposed budget was tentatively approved by the Caldwell County Fiscal Court on the 28th day of April, 2020, and approved as to form and classification by the State Local Finance Officer on May 6th, 2020.


